


Seasonal Outlook

- The climate outlook for the season 'February March April' is expected to be dry, with alternations of sunny days with short spells of showers, mostly without heavy rainfall.
- Rainfall and temperatures are expected to be normal to above normal.
- Sea Surface Temperatures (SSTs) are presently slightly above normal and are forecasted to remain warm into April and lasting till July.
- The Atmosphere is expected to contain little moisture during February-March-April, but increasing from May as the trade winds are expected to remain stronger than average.
