

## **Emergency Hurricane Safety Kit**

#### **2021 STORM NAMES**

#### Your 30-gallon trash bin should include:

Water (1gal./person/day) First Aid Kit Canned Foods Rubbing Alcohol, Hand sanitizers, (Manual) Can Opener hand soap Medicines First Aid Handbook Flashlight Candles & Matches (Battery-operated) Radio (Large) Garbage Bags **Batteries** Towels Sanitary Supplies **Blankets** ♦ Toothbrush/paste Pencils Children Material (Coloring Books, ♦ Soap etc.) ♦ Shampoo Tissues ♦ Sponge Drinks/Juices ♦ Cleanser: Disincline/Pine Nuts Sol/etc. **Dried Beans** ♦ Bleach: Clorox Rice/Pastas ♦ Toilet Paper Soups Gas Stove & (extra) Gas Paper Towels **Cooking Utensils Peanut Butter ♦** Cooking Pot Crackers ♦ Plastic Dishes Pocket Knife ♦ Plastic Utensils (Spoon, Fork, Change of Clothing Knife) Rain Coat & Boots **♦ Aluminum Foil** You should also:



- ✓ Check your portable radio and battery-operated lights & flashlights
- ✓ Monitor Weather Broadcasts for current conditions and advisories from the Meteorological Department St. Maarten.
- ✓ Rotate food supplies every six months
- ✓ If you seek shelter elsewhere (evacuate), be sure to post a prominent note telling where you've gone
- ✓ Provide for your pets, especially if you evacuate
